<sup>1</sup> The increase affects the fees payable under *An Act Respecting Immigration to Québec*, the Regulation respecting immigration consultants and the Regulation respecting the selection of foreign nationals as well as the fees for an *Évaluation comparative des études effectuées hors du Québec* (comparative evaluation for studies done outside Québec). The 0,74% adjustment corresponds to the increase in Québec's consumer price index for the period ending on September 30, 2016. It respects the requirements of Section 83.3 of the Québec government's *Financial Administration Act*.
